As the city grows, USCCO has an incredible opportunity to serve as a spiritual anchor for newcomers and long-time residents alike, creating a space for individuals to find purpose, connection, and healing.

With significant residential growth happening nearby, including thousands of new homes and multifamily units, there's a growing desire for spiritual services that foster a sense of belonging and well-being. USCCO's presence in this evolving neighborhood makes it ideally situated to meet the spiritual and community-building needs of a flourishing population.

Commitment to Mindfulness and Personal Transformation

Unity's emphasis on spiritual education, mindfulness, and personal transformation deeply resonates with the lifestyle and values of Bend's residents. As people in Bend seek deeper connections and holistic approaches to life, Unity provides the perfect space for personal growth, meditation, and interfaith connection.

What makes USCCO unique:

We are truly a WILD SOUL SANCTUARY, where we howl with delight, celebrating our time together on Sundays. There are strong healing ministries with the Divine Healers, Sound Baths, and Drumming Circles. Sol Shine, our group of musicians, provides us with a sense of joy and inspiration. We have attracted many Ministers from various churches who offer teachings of acceptance and oneness, to enhance our Unity ministry.

Locality: 63645 Scenic Dr, Bend, OR 97701 Bend, Oregon is the largest city in Central Oregon and the County seat. The smaller communities around Bend are Sisters, Redmond (home of our airport RDM), Prineville, Tumalo and La Pine. The population of Deschutes County is 212,573 people. We are one of the fastest growing cities/counties in the State.

Physical Description:

Unity Spiritual Community at One World Center is poised to become a beacon of spiritual growth and connection in Bend's rapidly expanding north end. Located at 63645 Scenic Drive—just across from the new Costco and adjacent to Highway 20—this nearly 5-acre campus offers a serene yet accessible setting for those seeking deeper meaning, healing, and community. As we prepare to welcome a new minister, Unity is committed to expanding its outreach, offering inclusive spiritual programming, mindfulness practices, and service opportunities that resonate with Bend's diverse and evolving population. The presence of Mia Sprouts Early Childhood Development Center on-site further enriches the sense of community, fostering intergenerational connections and support.

The surrounding area is undergoing significant transformation, presenting unique opportunities for Unity to engage with a growing population. Directly east of One World Center, Pahlisch Homes is developing the Caraway Master Plan—a 150-acre mixed-use project that over time will include over 500 housing units, with a mix of single-family homes and multifamily residences, and at least 77 units designated as affordable housing. To the south, Powell Development is advancing the Gateway North project, featuring a new Costco, retail spaces for lease, and plans for multifamily housing. These developments are set to introduce a substantial influx of residents, creating increased demand for spiritual, educational, and community services. USCCO is uniquely positioned to serve as a spiritual anchor in this burgeoning neighborhood, offering a welcoming space for reflection, connection, and growth.

USCCO, Bend, Oregon is in beautiful Central Oregon. Bend serves the communities of Redmond, Prineville, Sisters and LaPine, Oregon.

Weather and Climate: Bend is a semi-arid climate (High Desert) with four distinct seasons. It is dry (low humidity) and sunny much of the time. We average 12" of rain a year and an average of 27 inches of snow in Winter. Winter's average temperature is between 20 degrees F and 40 degrees F. Summer is dry, warm and sunny.

Proximity to Other Unity Ministries and/or New Thought Centers:

Bend is 163 miles or a 3 1/2 hour's drive from Portland, OR, the largest city in Oregon. We are 4-5 hours from the nearest Oregon Coast destination. The cities of Eugene and Salem are less than a 3 hour's drive.

The State of Oregon has several Unity ministries, one in Portland, Beaverton, Gresham, Eugene, Ashland and Salem and on the coast in Bandon. Centers for Spiritual Living are in the communities of Portland, Eugene, Medford, Grants Pass, Lake Oswego and Verona, a Summer Teen Camp. In Bend, we have over 20 fellowships such as Unitarian Universalist Fellowship, Story Dwelling, and the Hanai Foundation and the Sanctuary within the city limits.
