About the Ministry

OVERVIEW

Unity of Dallas is a spiritual community embracing a transition towards a new model of ministry. Over 80 years, we've had many dynamic ministers, who have brought both exciting highs and challenging lows. Too often, the minister ended up carrying the weight of everything, making success feel great when things were going well—but difficult during transitions or misalignments. In addition, our spiritual center has sometimes focused more on the minister's vision over the broader needs of the congregation. Our goal is to continue to create a healthier, more balanced leadership structure that supports the long-term thriving of our community.

We are actively transitioning to a **Mission-Centric** ministry focused on community-centered leadership and purpose-driven alignment. This shift moves us from simply receiving to taking ownership of our shared spiritual journey. Leadership still provides guidance as we are looking toward discovering what wants to emerge, what we're missing and where direction is needed. We have adopted the Evolutionary statement – "Transforming lives and inspiring people to make a positive difference in the world." **To support this transformation, we are seeking a mature, spiritually grounded Servant Leader to help guide our community toward its fullest potential as Unity of Dallas**.

Locality

Dallas, Texas offers a mix of big-city excitement and convenient living. Enjoy outstanding dining, vibrant arts and culture, easy access to an international airport and top-tier sports teams. We boast nearly 300 days of sunshine a year, mild winters, a beautiful spring and fall and abundant air-conditioning in the summer. Dallas is a city on the move with a diverse population and aspirations to be one of the world's great cities. With a booming job market, no state income tax, and a low cost of living compared to other major cities, Dallas is a great place to live and grow.

Unity of Dallas (UoD) has a beautiful 7.3 acre campus within a scenic neighborhood, covered with live oak trees and bordered by a lovely creek. The 40,000 sq. ft. main building contains a sanctuary that seats over 800, a Fellowship Hall (150 capacity), a chapel, book nook, and kitchen. The two floors upstairs hold offices, the boardroom and classrooms, including a large 200 seat multipurpose room. Downstairs is for Youth and Family Ministry and also hosts the thriving Meadowbrook private school as a well-paying tenant. In addition, there's a 2100 sq ft. former private residence that is owned by UoD.

SACRED SERVICE TEAMS

Unity of Dallas has many teams which are comprised of wonderful volunteers.

• Prayer Chaplains

This ministry is dedicated to prayer and spiritual support for individuals of our community. The chaplains conduct monthly prayer calls or emails with members, are available after Sunday service for individual prayer, hold sacred space during the Sunday service, pray during our Sunday Service from the platform, answer prayer requests from our prayer boxes, and make hospital visits for prayer.

• Greeting & Welcome Team

Greeters are often the first contact visitors have with UoD. The team members meet and greet everyone arriving at the center on Sunday before service and wish them well as they leave. This team also identifies newcomers to provide them with the UoD welcome packet and invite them to newcomer class. They follow up each newcomer with a welcome email.

Usher Team

Ushers greet guests as they enter the Sanctuary. The Ushers play an important role during services and events, ensuring that things run smoothly by assisting with seating, answering questions, and collecting the Love Offering.

Kitchen Angels

Our Kitchen Angels run a tight ship for our Sunday Coffee and Conversations, all the while fostering fellowship and making friends. They make coffee, prepare snacks, keep the refreshments flowing and leave everything sparkling afterwards. They also help handle potlucks and some special events that involve food.

Book Nook Team

This team rings up sales on Sunday mornings, accepts payments, answers guest questions and keeps up with inventory.

• Unity Kids Ministry Team

This team guides children and teens on their individual journeys of spiritual self-discovery each Sunday during the 11:00 am service.

• Office Volunteer Team

This team assists the center staff during the week by answering phone calls or checking messages remotely and completing various office tasks. They also assist with UoD projects as needed.

Special Events Team / Facilities

This team helps staff to support any special events hosted by Unity of Dallas, as well as events brought in by other groups, including contracts, marketing, set ups.

Card Angels

This team provides support for the UoD family during times of special need by sending cards and holding them in prayer.

AV Team

Works the audio visual for services in auditorium and Fellowship Hall during services, events, and large meetings.

• Choir/Music Team

Our music team provides song leadership during weekly services and our choir sings in service about once every month.

Platform Assistants

This team provides support on Sunday by making announcements, introducing speakers and leading the offering.

Marketing

We have a team of volunteers that helps our staff with marketing our own special events and drawing in renters for other events to more fully make use of our amazing building.

Décor/Gardens

A small group of people help organize stage set up, seasonal décor and oversee the gardens around the building.

• Licensed Unity Teachers

We have four active licensed teachers who teach classes, offer Sunday talks and are active in leadership at Unity of Dallas. We also have several retired LUTs that occasionally offer their services as well.

Community Outreach

North Dallas Shared Ministries

- NDSM is a multi-faceted relief organization with which we have partnered for many years.
 NDSM offers medical care, dental care, a clothes closet, food pantry, assistance with bills, assistance with tax prep, back to school help and others as needed.
- As a Covenant congregation, we have the opportunity to serve others in the Northwest Dallas area in sacred service. In orientation, we are told that when we serve there, we are doing church. We take part year-round in their Gleaning for Grocery collection of shelf stable foods for their pantry.
- As a Member congregation, our congregants in need may receive services, as can those who drop in to our center seeking financial assistance, food, etc.
- This covenant agreement includes a regular financial donation to the NDSM.

Soupmobile

- Soupmobile is a feeding and prayer ministry to the unhoused people of Dallas. We have partnered with them in a variety of ways over the past 10 years.
- We currently take donations to provide their request for \$5 gift cards to McDonalds, offering them the opportunity to dine with dignity in the establishments.
- At Christmas, we provide gift boxes for their Christmas day celebration.

Feed My Starving Children

 We offer the opportunity for congregants to meet monthly at this organization to pack food boxes which are distributed internationally.

Love Bears All

Each February, congregants bring plush toys to the sanctuary, where they're filled with love throughout the month. These stuffed animals are then donated to the Dallas Children's Advocacy Center where police, counselors, and legal teams come together to protect the best interests of children who have experienced violent crime, trauma, or abuse. Donations have also gone to other local agencies that support children in need.

IMPORTANT EVENTS IN UNITY OF DALLAS HISTORY

For over 80 years, Unity of Dallas has been a spiritual home for those seeking a deeper connection with God, personal transformation, and a welcoming community. Founded in **1942** by **Rev. Ruth Gillespie**, UoD quickly grew, moving several times before settling at **6525 Forest Lane** in **1973**, where it remains today.

Throughout the decades, Unity of Dallas has seen **dynamic leadership**, including **Dr. Donald Curtis**, who led us through major expansions in the 1970s and 1980s, culminating in the construction of an **800-seat sanctuary** in 1986. After his retirement in 1992, UoD experienced **periods of transition**, with several ministers guiding the congregation through change. Stability returned under **Rev. David McClure (1996–2003)** and later **Rev. Ellen Debenport (2003–2007)**, both of whom expanded outreach and educational programs.

In **2014**, UoD made a key decision to **sell a portion of its land** to retire the mortgage and fund renovations, creating **Myrtle Hall, an updated chapel, and a modernized kitchen**. **Rev. James Buchanan (2016–2023)** became the longest-tenured minister after Donald Curtis, establishing a regional SEE week and expanding outside rentals.

Today, under **Spiritual Liaison Deb Stovall LUT**, Unity of Dallas is transitioning to a **Mission-Centric Model**, fostering **shared leadership, accountability, and sustainable growth**. In addition to serving as a home for Unity of Dallas and Meadowbrook School, 6525 Forest Lane is also home to some of our regular rental clients. Including Church of God who rents our sanctuary and various rooms on Saturdays.

The center continues to serve as a spiritual home, a rental space for many activities, and a center for **personal and collective transformation**, ensuring its legacy for generations to come.

POSITION DESCRIPTION

JOB TITLE: SENIOR MINISTER, UNITY OF DALLAS

INTRODUCTORY STATEMENT:

We hold the belief that leadership is shared in a mission-centric approach, drawing forth the skills and talents of individuals throughout the ministry. A thriving Unity ministry has been created when a dedicated Senior Minister and members of the congregation serve together to design a quality Spirit-filled environment for all people. This job description serves as a guideline to ensure that all areas of the ministry are well managed.

As stated in the By-Laws of Unity of Dallas:

"The Senior Minister shall be an ordained or licensed Unity minister approved for ministry employment by Unity Worldwide Ministries or a person serving under special dispensation approved by Unity Worldwide Ministries."

"The Senior Minister shall be a voting member of the Board of Directors and serve as an ex-officio member of all ministry teams."

"The Senior Minister shall be accountable to the Board of Directors and shall receive an annual performance review from the Board."

HIGH LEVEL ORGANIZATION:

To allow the Minister to focus on spiritual matters, our community has adopted an organization with two leaders reporting directly to the Board: An Operations Director and a Senior Minister. The day-to-day running of the facility and supporting staff is led by the Operations Director while the Senior Minister leads staff focused on Sunday and special services and the overall spiritual health, care and education of the congregation.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Senior Minister is responsible for timely and consistently creating and delivering messages and programs embracing the Unity vision, providing a sound prayer consciousness on which to base all activities of the ministry to include:

Leads and coordinates the Sunday morning services which includes the minister's message, music

and meditation. Guides the spiritual direction of the ministry along lines in keeping with the teachings of Jesus Christ as interpreted by Unity and Unity Worldwide Ministries.

- Performs or coordinates pastoral duties such as hospital visitations and personal contact with those in need.
- Provides effective spiritual counseling and prayer to those who seek it.
- Working with volunteer Chairs and committee members, develops annual plans for educational classes, programs, speakers and events; Community Outreach programs; Youth/Family programs and events; Member Services events as they occur or as requested by members.
- Conducts weddings. funerals, memorials, christening and special spiritual services.
- Empowers and supports spiritual development of all youth programs.
- Commits to continued personal spiritual evolution.

Staff Relations: (Staff is a generalized term meaning paid employees of Unity of Dallas, contract workers and Unity volunteers).

- The Director of Music reports directly to the Senior Minister.
- The Senior Minister works with direct reports in planning objectives and performance goals in addition to motivational activities that may work to enhance the work environment.
- Completes annual performance reviews for staff members reporting to him/her for submission to the Board. Assists Board in defining annual salary budgets and individual pay adjustments with the exception of Board discussions concerning the Minister's compensation.
- Consults the Board Human Resources Chair on personnel issues and in developing job descriptions, employee policies and procedures, and changes to the employee handbook,
- Promotes volunteer involvement by supporting volunteer efforts and participating in the endeavor when possible.

Fiscal Responsibility:

- Creates a spiritual atmosphere of "giving", fostering the shared responsibility of maintaining Unity of Dallas both spiritually and physically.
- Stays apprised of the daily financial status of the church through consultation with the Operations Director and the Treasurer of the Board of Directors.

- Assists Board in developing and revising annual budgets, both operating and capital that are within the Senior Minister's area of responsibilities.
- Approves and directs purchases and expenditures that are within the limits of the Board approved budget and are related to the Senior Minister's responsibilities.
- Retains responsibility for the sound financial execution of his/her ministry programs as planned and approved in coordination with the Board of Directors.

Relationship with Board of Directors:

- Regularly attends all Board meetings and serves as liaison to Board committees.
- Provides the Board with adequate information to help it reach sound decisions and policies.
- Cooperates with the Board president to create the agenda for congregational meetings.
- Communicates with the Board on progress, activities and direction of the ministry.
- Supervises the implementation of all policies and procedures as set by the Board that are within the Senior Minister's responsibilities.
- Assists the Board in developing sound short-term and long-range plans.
- Reports regularly to the Board about progress toward ministerial goals and objectives.
- Is in collaboration with the Board, ensuring that decisions are aligned with the mission/vision and in the best interest of the ministry.

Community Outreach and Public Relations:

- Serves as spokesperson of Unity ministry in all dealings with the public, media, and other organizations.
- Promotes good public relations.
- Ensures the membership is informed of activities, opportunities and direction of ministry (i.e. newsletters, bulletins, personnel).

Unity Movement Participation:

- Regularly attends the annual conventions for Unity Worldwide Ministries and the region.
- Supports Unity Worldwide Ministries, abides by its ethics and policies, and the region through service (officer, committee membership, other activities or participation).
- Regularly informs the Board and membership of the policies, directions, activities and service provided by Unity Worldwide Ministries, the region and Unity.

- Embraces the use of social media platforms (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.) in support of the ministry's mission, vision, and values.

- Ministry Location: Our ministry is primarily in person. We stream online through
 Facebook. There is a small online presence during these services but generally several
 hundred views during the week.
- **Ministry Type:** Our congregation is moving toward a mission centric model. Our minister will serve alongside an Operations Director and our Board of Directors to lead us spiritually in such a way as to help hold us accountable to our chosen mission.
- **Age Groups:** Our current demographic includes all ages, with a preponderance of those being over 50. We are in the process of rebuilding our youth and family ministry while celebrating all of our current age groups for their accumulated wisdom and experience.
- Interests/Area of Expertise: Having invested in a mission centric ministry, we are seeking a visionary leader who is willing to accompany us on this path of transformation.

 - Working alongside our chaplains, the minister supports congregants during times of need.
 - Working with our LUTs to promote spiritual education of all types.
