About the Ministry

OVERVIEW

Unity in Lynnwood is a heart-centered, welcoming community that emphasizes inclusion and active spirituality. The Youth and Family program is vibrant, drawing in young people from outside the community and producing youth leaders both regionally and nationally. The prayer ministry is composed of a dedicated team of six trained chaplains who are in regular contact with members, both on Sundays and through outreach. Our services are dynamic and joyful! We benefit from a strong technology team that provides online access seamlessly. Our services richly feature music, currently under the leadership of Kelly Ash, talented singer and pianist.

Locality:

Lynnwood is located sixteen miles north of Seattle, with easy access to the city by light rail. Arts, museums, dining, major universities, all make our location a vibrant cultural hub. This part of Snohomish County combines urban convenience with the beauty of the Pacific Northwest. Majestic views of Mount Rainier to the south, the Cascade Mountain range to the east, and the Olympics to the west, as well as the proximity of Puget Sound with its ferries to multiple islands, all offer endless opportunities for appreciation of nature.

Physical Description:

Unity in Lynnwood began with five families in the Fall of 1980. It subsequently grew to be able to build a beautiful new church in 2003. The large sanctuary windows look out onto five acres of protected woodland that belong to the church. The attractiveness of our facility also makes it a desirable location to rent for multiple cultural and celebratory functions. An outdoor gazebo and garden serve as a chapel for weddings and lovely site for outdoor concerts and social events.

The church building was designed with a lower floor that is currently rented by the Wee Care Academy, which provides childcare and early education for children 0-5 years old. Wee Care is a 501.c.3 non-profit corporation with its own Board of Directors. Unity in Lynnwood is the "sole member" of the Wee Care 501.c.3, therefore the Unity in Lynnwood Board of Trustees has authority over the Wee Care Board of Directors. Wee Care Academy's excellent service makes it sought after by parents and provides a stable income that offsets the church mortgage.
