The Church:

Unity Church in the Woods has an opening for a fulltime Unity Minister. The church is located on a beautiful 10-acre, wooded campus in the heart of Bradenton, Florida. It serves folks in the Bradenton & Sarasota areas.

Duties:

Duties include (1) giving the Sunday message, (2) teaching classes, (3) promoting church socials, and (4) ministering to the congregation's needs (hospital visits, home visits, etc.). We are looking for a minister who is pro-growth; an individual who will embrace the ministry with energy, enthusiasm, and integrity. We require that lessons and services be based on biblical teachings and classical unity principles.

Congregation:

Presently, the congregation is small – averaging 25-35 attendees on Sunday. We have seen much higher numbers (200 plus) prior to COVID. The area is growing rapidly and rebuilding the congregation would not be difficult.

Compensation:

- (1) 75% of Sunday tithes
- (2) \$1,000/month stipend
- (3) \$500/month expense account
- (4) 75% of class income
- (5) Two-week paid vacation
- (6) Medical reimbursements negotiable
- (7) Moving expenses negotiable

Governance:

The church is not governed by the congregation, nor do our bylaws conform to UWM guidelines. The church is governed and supported privately by the Bazzy family.

Description:

The church sits on a beautiful 10-acre, heavily wooded campus in the center of Bradenton, Florida. It is located five miles from Anna Maria Island and the Gulf of Mexico beaches. Anna Maria Island is the southernmost island that forms Tampa Bay.

Marina assets are made available to the church. This is a huge boost for church social events. For example, the church can use boats for shelling and snorkeling, jet skis, dolphin sightseeing tours and the Anna Maria Princes, a 125-passenger paddlewheel boat.

Anna Maria Island is one of the fastest growing Islands on Florida's west coast. It has been voted the #1 tourist destination for years, as well as the top wedding venue in the country.
